Recharge is a young person and community-led organisation based in Tranent, East Lothian that works closely with the local community. In late 2014, Recharge commissioned Northern Star to evaluate the impact of the organisation.

Recharge has two distinct services:

- * Recharge Connect focuses on making and sustaining the connection with young people by running drop-in nights, trip programmes and detached youth work
- * Recharge Extra looks to advance and deepen the connection made with the young people by offering 1-to-1 support, issue based group work and youth participation

Between 500 and 600 young people a year use Recharge's services.

Impact on young people

- * Young people feel listened to, valued and safe.
- * Young people are able to meet up with friends and socialise as well as meet new people
- * Young people increase their confidence and self esteem
- * Young people develop a greater awareness of the negative effects of risky and harmful behaviour

- * Young people have broader horizons and higher aspirations through exposure to new experiences and access to positive role models
- * Young people have learnt to manage their anger leading to improvement in behaviour

Impact on the Community

- * A partnership between Recharge, Police Scotland, Ross High School and East Lothian Council is making a significant impact on reported anti-social behaviour - a 65% drop between 2008/09 and 2014/15
- * Young people are more involved in decision making in the local community

Recharge plays an important role in helping local organisations work effectively together for the benefit of young people. It is a highly respected and valued organisation by young people and partner organisations. The facility is viewed as hugely important for Tranent and the surrounding areas.
